### Information on personal data processing

This paper includes information on how we treat Your personal data, how to contact us if you have any questions regarding the processing of Your personal data and other important information on the processing of Your personal data. We recommend that you read this information thoroughly. This information may be subject to change. By the processing of Your personal data we conform to the Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal data protection as amended and Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and related provisions.

#### Personal data we process:

**Identification data:** Name, surname, title, ID-card No., car registration No. of the vehicle entering our area

**Vide records:** Video records you can be identifiable on.

#### Purpose of the processing of Your personal data:

**We process Your personal data on the base of our legitimate interests for the following purposes:**

##### **Keeping the book of visits**

**Monitoring of premises/area** Monitoring of our areas and reserved inner rooms in our building by means of a camera system.

Keeping the book of visits and monitoring are pursued especially due to the protection of our property and Your safety. By monitoring we try not to infringe Your privacy or to infringe it as little as possible.

#### How long we store your personal data:

Data in the book of visits will be stored for 3 years after the respective year.

Video records from the camera system are stored for 15 days after the day on which they were made. After this storage time we provide immediate disposal of personal data.

#### Are you obliged to provide Your personal data?

If you visit us, you are obliged to identify yourself for the purpose of visit records and we will process the video recording on which you can be identifiable. In case you don't provide us with Your personal data, we are entitled not to let you enter our area.

#### Who will be Your personal data shared with?

**Intermediaries** who process Your personal data on our behalf only on the base of documented contractual instructions:

- IT-services providers
- Occupational health and safety and occupational health service providers
- External private safety service

Your personal data will not be transferred into third countries.

### **What are your rights?**

#### **Right to the access to Your personal data**

Upon request, you are entitled to get information from us on which personal data about You we process and copies of Your personal data. Rights of third parties cannot be limited hereby.

#### **Right to the correction or amendment of personal data**

Personal data must be correct, up-to-date and true. Upon request, you are entitled to the correction of incorrect personal data and amend incomplete personal data. Exercising of this right helps us keep Your personal data correct and up-to-date.

#### **Besides several legal exceptions, You also have the following rights:**

#### **Right to the deletion of personal data**

Upon request, you are entitled to the deletion of Your personal data, if the purpose of the processing has terminated or personal data are processed illegally.

#### **Right to limited processing**

Upon request, you are entitled to the blocking of Your personal data.

#### **Right to the transfer of Your personal data**

Upon request, you are entitled to acquire Your personal data, which we process, in a structured, commonly used and machine readable format and you are entitled to request the transfer of these personal data to another operator, if technically possible. Rights of third parties cannot be limited hereby.

#### **Right to object to the processing of Your personal data**

You are entitled to object to the processing of Your personal data.

#### **How to exercise Your rights**

You can exercise Your rights by sending a written application per post to our address, personally or electronically to the e-mail address: [lucia.prokesova@arcelormittal.com](mailto:lucia.prokesova@arcelormittal.com).

We will respond to Your application regarding the processing of personal data forthwith within one month from its delivery. In special cases the term may be prolonged by two more months, but in either case we will inform you on the reasons of the prolonged period within one month from the reception of the application. All information are free. Shall your applications be inadequate or repeated too often, we can request an adequate administrative fee for their processing.

You are entitled to file a request for the initiation of a proceeding to the supervisory body (Office for personal data protection of the Slovak Republic, Hraničná 12, 820 07 Bratislava 27, e-mail: [statny.dozor@pdp.gov.sk](mailto:statny.dozor@pdp.gov.sk)) if you suspect that the processing of Your personal data is in contradiction with these conditions or current legislation.
